

Identifying CSE

- Warning signs and vulnerabilities checklist (appendix A Peninsula CSE protocol)
- Risk Indicator Tool (Appendix F)

Threshold tool – Behaviour (page 8)

Level 1

- Appropriate sexual development and activity

- Requires universal services only

Suggested direct working tools

Child Y/P displaying CSE vulnerabilities.
No evidence to suggest child is suspected to be involved in CSE.
Intervention to reduce the risk of them becoming involved.

Level 2

- Child suspected to be at risk of involvement in child sexual exploitation

- Establish DAF (gain consent from family complete form DAF1 & register)
- Consider referral to MACSE forum (Appendix E Peninsula CSE protocol)

Cases where CSE vulnerabilities and indicators are present but there is a lack of evidence to conclude the child is involved in CSE

Level 3

- Child suspected to be involved in child sexual exploitation

- MASH enquiry
- Open case complete from M7
- Consider CSE referral to REACH (message CSEMISS)

- Consultation between REACH team and referrer
- 1-2-1 support from REACH or
- Reach supported (via consultation) direct work with young person

CSE vulnerabilities and indicators identified along with evidence that the child is at risk of or involved in CSE

Level 4

- Significant evidence child is involved in child sexual exploitation

- MASH enquiry
- Open case complete form M7
- Consider CSE referral to REACH (message CSEMISS)
- Strategy meeting

- Consultation between REACH team and referrer
- 1-2-1 support from REACH or
- Reach supported (via consultation) direct work with young person. Including regular reviews.
