What is a child protection conference?

This is a meeting where people like your teachers, doctor, social worker and family will get together to talk because there are worries about your safety. These people will talk about what is going well for you and what else could be done to make things better. If something is happening that shouldn't be, they will talk about how to make it stop.

They will make a plan of things that everyone needs to do to help you be safe and happy.

2 Would you like to meet the chairperson (who leads the meeting) before the meeting?

They will explain to you exactly what will happen at the meeting and how you will be involved and you can talk about any questions or worries about the meeting with them. They will also meet with your parents/carers.

An advocate can support you and help you to share your thoughts and feelings at the child protection conference.

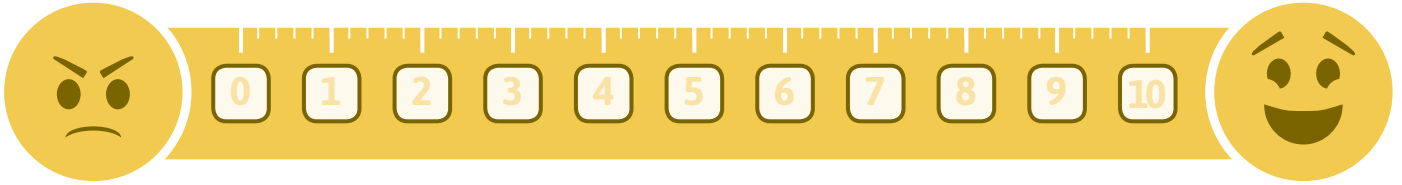

Draw around your hand and on each finger write the name of someone who could become part of a team of helpers....



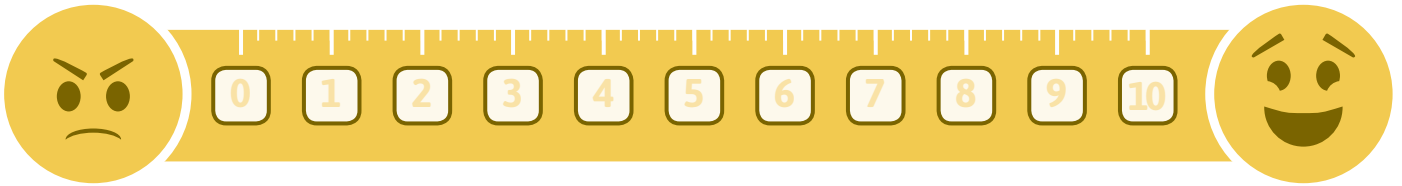

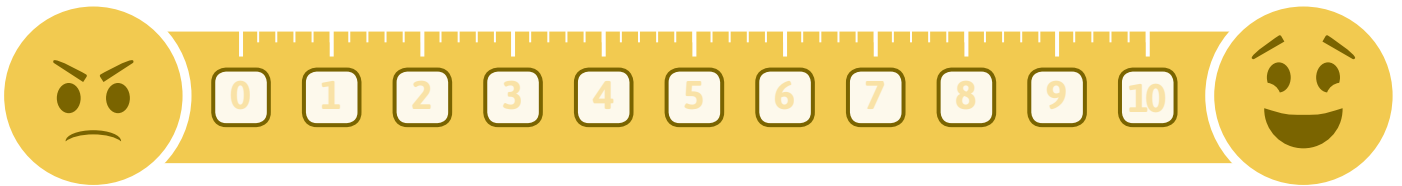
