A return interview is an opportunity for you to talk about when you were missing recently. You will be given time to talk and find out what would make a difference to you.



WHO WILL BE INTERVIEWING ME?

You will be offered an interview from your social worker but if you feel you would like to talk to someone else about your experience, you may find it useful to speak to someone who is independent from your social worker. If you want someone from the Young Lives Foundation (YLF) to talk to you, they can arrange with you a suitable time, day and place to meet.



WHO ARE YLF?
