

## **CiN Planning – update to Child in Need Plans and Reviews chapter**

When a child ceases to be the subject of a Child Protection Plan, a Child in Need Plan is likely to be necessary for a minimum of three months in order that the child and family continue to receive services. In exceptional circumstances, a CiN Plan may not be required; for example, if the child is removed from home or the risk has been entirely reduced (the source of the risk has gone, a Special Guardianship Order has been acquired, etc).
