
## Referral to social care - child presenting with harmful sexual behaviours. MARF form completed

If this is a new referral, ensure that the child with concerning behaviours and the victim have separate social workers.

Use Harmful Sexual Behaviour Framework NSPCC (p.15) / Brook Traffic Light Tool to determine seriousness of behaviour

A Harmful Sexual Behaviours plan can only be ended in a multi-agency meeting. If a YP is convicted of a sexual offence and registered as a sex offender then MAPPA arrangements will be in place.
