



Behaved in a way that has caused harm or may have caused harm.

Possibly committed a criminal offence against or related to the person in placement.

Behaved towards person in placement in a way that indicated s/he is unsuitable.

Strategy discussion led by safeguarding officer (LADO.)
Action plans agreed.

Internal Action:

- Support via Foster Talk/ Legal Advice
- Support for person in placement
- Policy review
- Training and Development

Decision made whether placement can remain within the home.

Police Investigation of a possible criminal offence

Assessment by social workers. S47 (if a child) or assessment strategy (for adults)

Suspension Disciplinary and Dismissal procedures.

Reviews

LADO (for children) tracks progress, monitors outcomes and reports to the Safeguarding Children Partnership and other relevant agencies. If an adult is in placement, the Adult Protection Manager will monitor vulnerable adults allegations and link to the Safeguarding Adults Board. It will be signposted to other agencies.
