Visiting Framework

The timescales for visiting all children must be driven by the child's plan, needs and risk, but at a minimum as set out within this document





Practice Expectations	Person Responsible
 Decisions about when/how often practitioners visit are taken in supervision, with these decisions recorded on the case record and in the child's plan 	
 Visits should always be in line with the child's needs and identified risk. 	Manager &
• For statutory visits children will be seen at their home, will be seen alone and their sleeping arrangements viewed.	Social Worker
• Children aged four and above will be seen alone at statutory visits unless there is a clear rationale, in agreement with a manager and clearly recorded on the child's file.	
Contacts made to Barnsley Childrens Social Care	
• If a Section 47 enquiry is triggered, the child is visited according to risk and need, but as a minimum the child would usually need to be seen (and usually seen alone) within 24 hours of the Section 47 starting or as agreed within the strategy discussion	Social Worker
• If a Section 17 assessment is triggered, the child must be seen in a timescale agreed with a manager and always within 5 working days	
Child in Need	
The minimum standard is every 4 weeks	Social Worker
• Visits should be at a level to build and sustain a relationship with the child and carers and drive forward the plan.	
Children Subject to a Child Protection Plan	
 Children must be seen every 10 working days, at home and on their own where they are over 4 years of age. Visits should take place within 48 hours of the initial case conference or as set by the Initial Child Protection Conference 	Social Worker

Children with temporarily approved foster carers or parents under Interim Care Order:	
 Visits should be weekly until the first review Visits should be every 4 weeks thereafter until the carer is approved or final hearing completed 	Social Worker
Children made subject to a Care Order and placed at home with parents	
 A visit should take place within the first week of the placement Visits shall take place weekly until the first review Children will be seen at a minimum of every four weeks As with all visits, visits will take place in line with the needs of the child and their plan and as agreed at the LAC review 	Social Worker
Children Vulnerable to Exploitation:	
 Children will be seen at a minimum in line with the visiting timescales of the plan they are subject to. We understand the importance of building a working relationship with vulnerable young people and our level of contact with the young person will reflect this. 	Social Worker
Children reported as missing:	
• The child will be visited within 72 hours of their return	Return Home Interviewer
