Reason for Involvement:

[REDACTED] lives at home with her Mum [REDACTED], Sister [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] is subject to a CP plan under the category of sexual abuse because of sexual convictions against children, which her father, [REDACTED] holds. [REDACTED] has no contact with her father until all the specialist risk assessments are completed and it is deemed safe for her to do so. However, [REDACTED] has shared that she wishes to resume a relationship with [REDACTED] and wants [REDACTED] to have unsupervised contact with him.

[REDACTED] has also suffered sexual abuse by her brother, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] is vulnerable and there have not been any appropriate ability to protect assessments completed of Mother, [REDACTED] and although [REDACTED] is not due for release as of yet, there are concerns that because of [REDACTED] views, where she does not acknowledge the risk [REDACTED] poses, she is not deemed a safety factor and appropriate assessments needs to be completed for Mother and potentially [REDACTED] in relation to [REDACTED].

Part 2 - Write Up

Analysis of information

Case allocation – hypothesis / reflections:

Further ability to protect assessment is required by anybody who would be supervising contact between [REDACTED] and her Brother-in-law, [REDACTED] who is convicted of sexual offences against children. Exploration into what information [REDACTED] knows about [REDACTED] and whether this should be shared with [REDACTED] for her to be more informed regarding any further contact she has. [REDACTED] has been a victim of sexual abuse by her brother, [REDACTED] and is therefore likely to be more vulnerable.

Action	<p>Actions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Read Referral and MASH Assessment in full – by 05.10.2020 - Liaise with allocated social worker for [REDACTED] to share information and establish if they have completed an Ability to Protect Assessment of [REDACTED] – by 06.10.20 - Liaise with sex offender manager for [REDACTED] and probation worker to establish the risks he poses – by 08.10.20 - Joint Home visit to be completed with Exp SW/Snr Prac to share and obtain Induction Pack and consent for C&F Assessment - by 09.10.2020 - Establish who [REDACTED] partner is and if she has children. If she does, referrals will need to be made to MASH [REDACTED] – by 09.10.20 - Add Case Summary (following Recording Guidance) – no later than 1 day after initial home visit - Ensure Chronology is up-to-date and clear – 12.10.2020 - Explore [REDACTED] relationships and complete at least three generational genogram and upload to her file. Be clear who [REDACTED] has contact with within the family network, identify any other risky adults within the family network, and any safe family members who are able to support the family. Ascertain [REDACTED] understanding about [REDACTED] and consider whether this should be shared with her to be more informed regarding any further time she spends with [REDACTED] – by 12.10.20 - Check Point 1 to be completed with [REDACTED] (Experienced Social Worker) – by 16.10.2020 - Establish when [REDACTED] will be released and consider what, if any, risk assessments can be completed/started now, as we know he is a risk and is a convicted offender – by 30.10.20 - Check Point 2 and CF15 Case discussion with [REDACTED] – by 30.10.2020 - Ability to Protect Assessments to be completed of parent alongside C&F Assessment ready for quality assurance by [REDACTED] (Snr Prac) to include mother's family history and wider family networks given [REDACTED] was sexually abused by her brother, [REDACTED] Have there been previous risky adults in the home which mother has allowed contact with the children? – by 06.11.2020 - C&F Assessment to be completed for quality assurance by [REDACTED] – by 06.11.2020 (25 days) - Undertake C&F Assessment under statutory requirements and consider the below points – by 20.11.2020 (35 day) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Ensure [REDACTED] voice is ascertained via age and stage appropriate direct work, and that she is given the opportunity to speak freely to the Social Worker. * Explore parents's history .i.e. current and past relationships, living history, childhood trauma which could impact on parenting capacity. Ask parents about any childhood experiences of sexual abuse. * Ascertain mother's views of the concerns. * Establish [REDACTED] father's details and include in C&F Assessment (consider any risk/threat to [REDACTED] and mother before doing so). * Consideration into whether [REDACTED] requires any further therapeutic work given her experiences - has she applied for victim compensation? * Assess what life is like for [REDACTED] * Ensure all relationships are added and linked on [REDACTED] file. * Ensure home environment and child's bedroom are viewed and assessed as appropriate. * Explore the involvement of professionals/agencies working with/supporting the family. What are their views of the assessment of risk and need regarding [REDACTED]? * Complete a Signs of Safety mapping with the family, encouraging them to think about what is working well? What are they worried about? and What needs to happen/ change? * Complete Danger Statements and Safety Goals with the family (these can be completed in draft first before discussing with the family).
