Child or young person requiring a Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) medical examination at the Queen's Medical Centre

Decision at a strategy meeting that a child needs a medical examination for possible FGM

Social Worker or Police to make a direct referral by contacting the Safeguarding Team at East Midlands Sexual Assault Service (EMCYPSAS) at QMC Nottingham 24-hour Single Point of Access (SPA) 0800 183 0023

**EMCYPSAS Strategy and Patient Pathway** 

Social Worker to notify DDICB Childrens Commissioners and Designated Doctor for Safeguarding

A Crisis Support Worker (CSW) will contact Doctor on the rota (or OOH Doctor) to arrange strategy discussion or if already discussed at a strategy discussion to agree a plan to determine if the examination is required. Arrange a date and time for examination (within 5 days) if required. Social care to provide interpreters.

NB depending on the forensic window strategy meeting/discussion may be after the examination

If FGM diagnosis is confirmed, screening for blood borne infections will be offered. Further investigations or referrals will be actioned by the local Derby or Derbyshire paediatrician on receipt of the report through locally commissioned services

A handwritten summary of examination findings will be given to the attending social worker and/or Police Officer.

A typed report will be distributed within 5 working days to the GP, Childrens Social Worker, Derby and Derbyshire ICB Designated Doctor, Police (if involved), Social Worker and Derbyshire Healthcare Foundation Trust Safeguarding team (<a href="mailto:dmh-tr.safeguardingchildrenunit@nhs.net">dmh-tr.safeguardingchildrenunit@nhs.net</a>).
