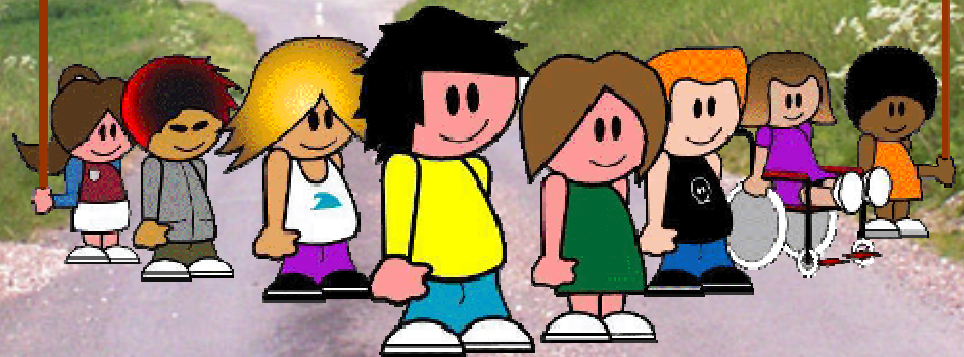

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How is Fostering for you?

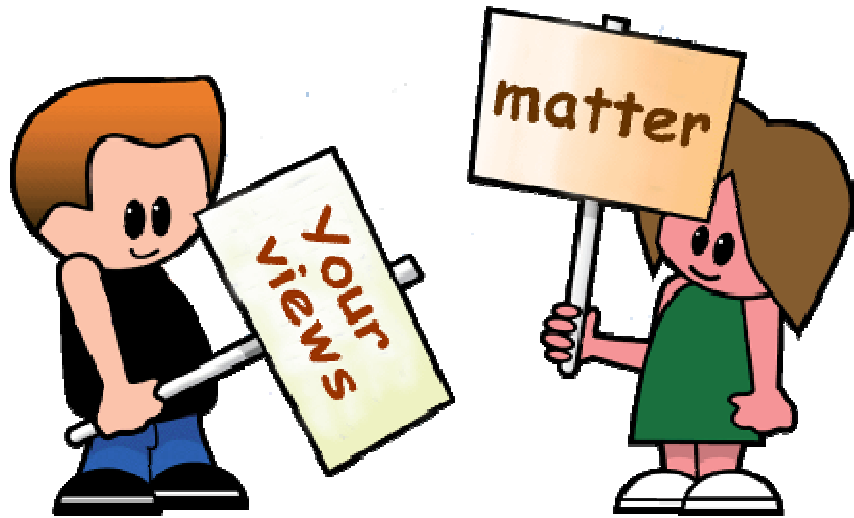

It is your chance to tell us how fostering is for you, what's good about it, or what you find difficult.

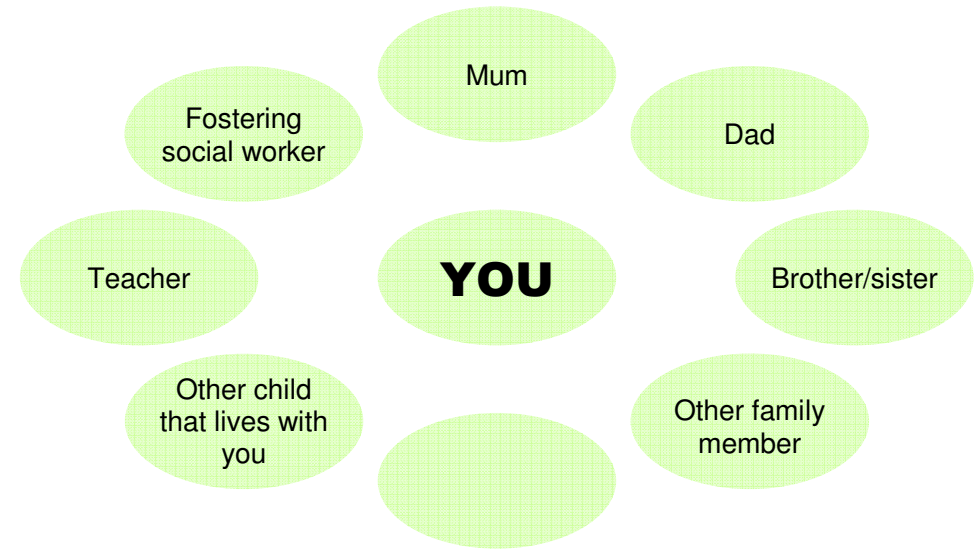
The information you give will normally be shared at your parent/s fostering review.

There is more information on the back page about who you can contact if you want to talk to someone in person, or if there is something you want us to know, but would not want to be raised at the review.

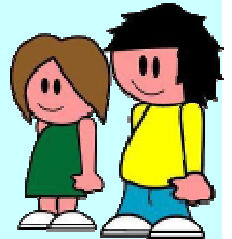


Thank you for spending some time filling in this form, as it is important we know how things are for you.

Is there anything else you want to say about being part of a foster family ?

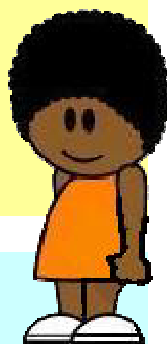

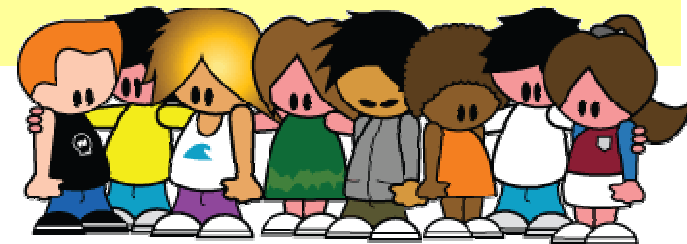

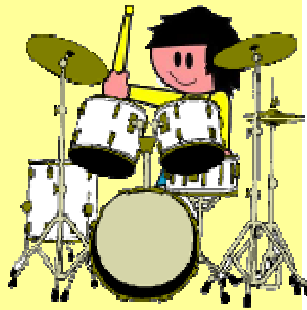
