Provided the child in your care was Looked After by a Local Authority before the SGO was granted, you are entitled to:

- A Post SGO assessment of need
- Access to the apeutic Support for your child and your family
- Financial assessment, advice and guidance
- A dedicated phoneline and email address (see over)
- Training and awareness events
- Access to peer support groups and events
- Advice, information and signposting to other agencies
- Access to independent and confidential support for birth parents of children subject to an SGO (First Family Support)
