NAME OF FILM:	LEAKED
RUNNING TIME:	7.50 mins
KEY TOPIC AREAS:	The impact of sharing inappropriate photos on Social Media
CHARACTERS:	Alice – Victim Liam – Alice’s boyfriend Tom – Liam’s friend Harry – Liam’s friend (Positive Bystander) Millie – Alice’s friend (Positive Bystander)
<p>Leaked tells the story and impact of sharing inappropriate photos / images on social media on both the victim and the offender.</p> <p>Alice and Liam have both shared photos with each other, but Liam has betrayed Alice’s trust and shared them across a wider network – without realising the consequences for both himself of Alice. Look out for the Bystanders; Harry and Millie and the impact their positive support has on Alice’s actions.</p>	
QUESTIONS / ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION AND DISCUSSION	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discuss experiences of this issue with the audience • Is it acceptable / not acceptable – examine thoughts / link to if it happened to a close family member • TRUST – what does this mean to the audience? How does it impact of healthy relationships and how can it influence life moving forward into adulthood? • If someone betrayed you, how would that make you feel? • What would you do if you were: A. Alice, B. Liam, C. Tom, D. Harry, E. Millie • What could the positive bystanders Harry and Millie do to educate negative bystanders such as Tom. • Are negative Bystanders as bad as the offenders themselves if they do nothing to stop this behaviour. • What role does Peer Pressure play in this film and how can we do the right thing? • Unhealthy relationships – where to go for advice and support?
