Dispute Resolution Process

At no time must a professional disagreement distract from ensuring the adult at risk is safeguarded

A referrer disagrees with the safeguarding outcome or decision

Where an adult or their advocate disagrees with the safeguarding outcome or decision

Discussion with the decision maker.

Rationale must be given for the decision as per the Northumberland Safeguarding

All disagreements will be fully recorded on the adult's records and within minutes of any safeguarding meetings.
