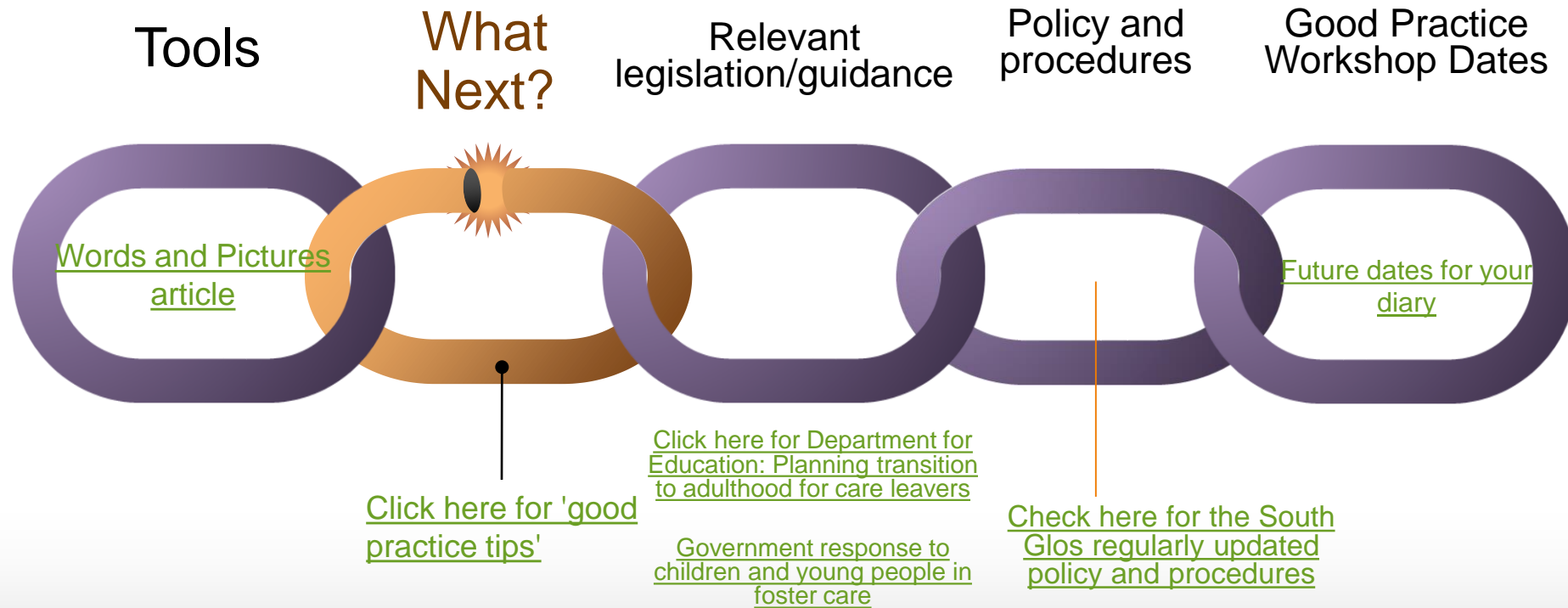
Children in Care & Care Leavers

What are we worried about?

- 70% of records did not have up to date chronologies
- Words and pictures were not evident in the cases audited
- Delay is common in the completion of Pathway Plans
- Management oversight is not consistently good
- Recording is not consistently up to date
- We are not consistently meeting our statutory requirements in terms of visiting and timeliness of reports.

This Learning Brief is based on the audit findings from Feb and March 2019 for **Children in Care and Care Leavers**. This was a sample of 10 audits, over a 2-month period, unfortunately over 50% less than the full cohort expected. This sample is too small for a full analysis at this point and therefore this is only a snap shot of what we can learn from our practice.

Further analysis of these findings will be included within the quarter 4 audit report in May 2019.
