If you are feeling unhappy or unsure about adoption, or want to know more about what adoption is, there are many places that you can go to for advice and some of them are in this booklet.

These places offer adoption support.

Adoption support can help you:

- talk about adoption
- understand your 'life story'
- choose who to tell you are adopted, and how much to tell them
- stay safe and in control on the internet
- discuss worries about your birth family
- with contact arrangements

We will listen to you to find out what you need, and help you and your parents discuss how you feel with someone who understands about adoption.

We hold family days during the year where you can meet up with other adopted children and their families.


