

## Guide to SW/Team Manager Responsibilities: Who can do what when

A brief – and not exhaustive - guide to key social work tasks and who can carry them out.

(NB. Any employed person, or student, with an enhanced DBS can carry out direct work with families but statutory CP and LAC visits can only be carried out by Social Work England registered Social Workers.)

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<sup>\*</sup>Adoption work should be carried out by the following:

- (a) A SW who has at least three years' post-qualifying experience in childcare social work, including direct experience of adoption work; or
- (b)is supervised by a social worker who-
  - (i) is employed by the local authority or registered adoption society in question; and
  - (ii)has at least three years' post-qualifying experience in childcare social work, including direct experience of adoption work.

## Note

Any exceptions or variations to the above requirements should be agreed with the ASYE Social Worker, ASYE mentor and Team Manager, signed off by the Head of Locality or Service, and added to the supervision record.
